

90 Minute Beaver Hike on Stoke Common

- Leave Walter Davies by the gate at the far corner of the site and turn left onto Stoke Common
- Take the right hand path of the three paths signposted in front of you, which goes diagonally to the right. As you approach the road keep the houses to your right. You will arrive at the road almost opposite a bus stop
- After crossing the road take the path to your right and keep walking along the fence, keeping the fence on your right. As you meet a couple of turns keep to the footpath running along the edge of the common. Keep the fence (and boundary of the common) on your right and continue to walk alongside the fence until you reach the road. Some of this section is narrow,
- Upon reaching the road you will turn very sharp left, almost turning back on yourself. Continue on the path as it twists and turns until you reach a crossroads with a bench that looks like its made of surf boards. Turn right at this junction
- Continue straight and at the next junction with a wooden Frog Sculpture turn left.
- Follow this path back to the road. Cross straight over the road, retracing your steps from the beginning of the walk and you will arrive at the back gate of Walter Davies in a few minutes

Notes:

Be aware the ground in some parts of the common can become soft during periods of heavy rain – sturdy footwear is a good idea

Cows often graze on the common to help maintain the area – just worth being aware of

There are a couple of locations on the return leg of the walk that could be suitable for a snack break or picnic
